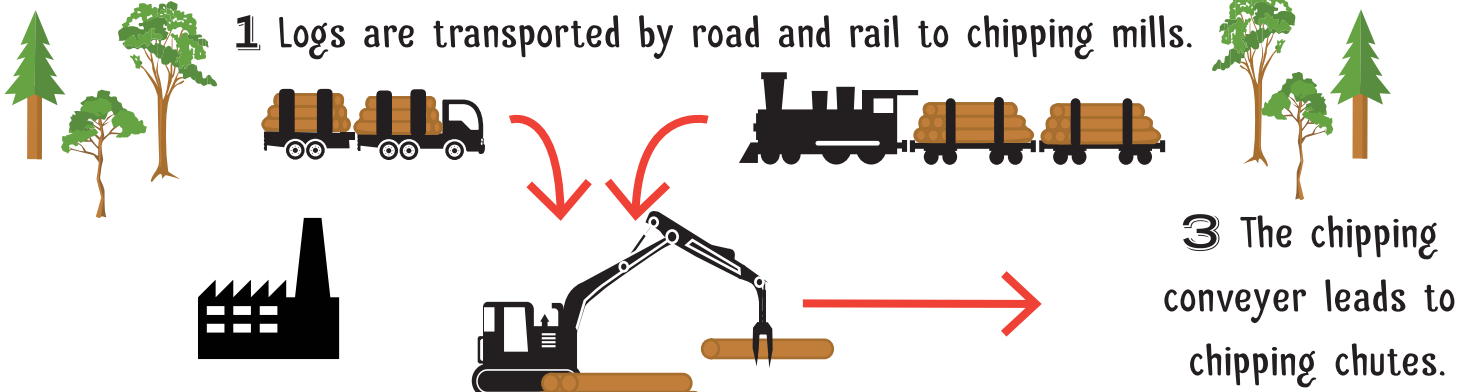


FROM SAW TO WOOD CHIPS

1 Logs are transported by road and rail to chipping mills.



2 At the mill logs are loaded onto a chipping conveyer.

5 The wood chips are sieved and any oversized pieces are removed.

6 The wood chips are then stored in piles.

8 They are placed on chutes that feed the loading conveyers.

3 The chipping conveyer leads to chipping chutes.

4 They pass through a radial chipper, which chops the logs into wood chips.

7 Wood chips are 'recovered' or 'reclaimed' from storage piles using bulldozers.

9 They are shipped around the globe to countries including: China, India, Japan and Taiwan.
