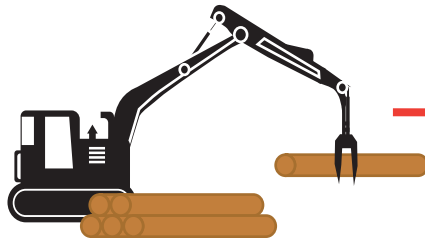
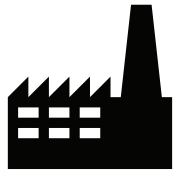


# FROM SAW TO WOOD CHIPS



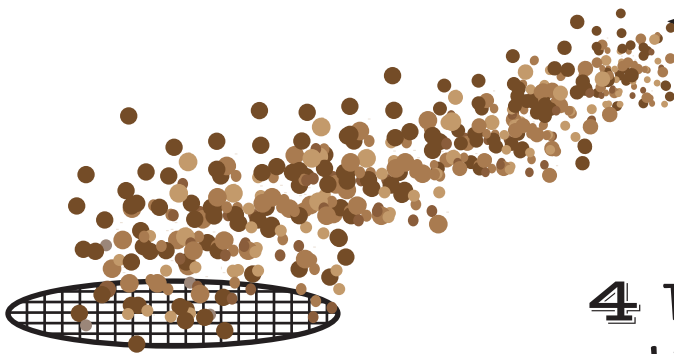
1 Logs are transported by road and rail to chipping mills



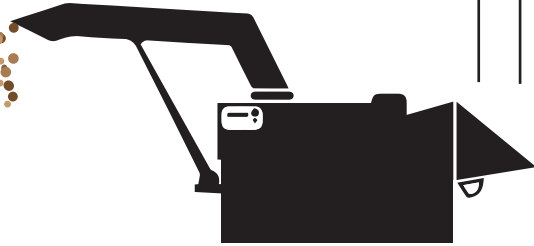
3 The chipping conveyor leads to chipping chutes



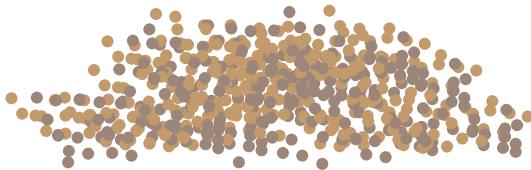
2 At the mill logs are loaded onto a chipping conveyor



4 They pass through a radial chipper, which chops the logs into wood chips

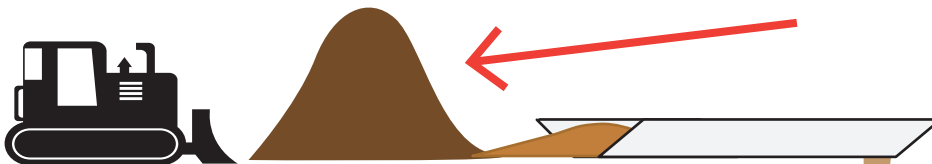


5 The wood chips are sieved and any oversized pieces are removed

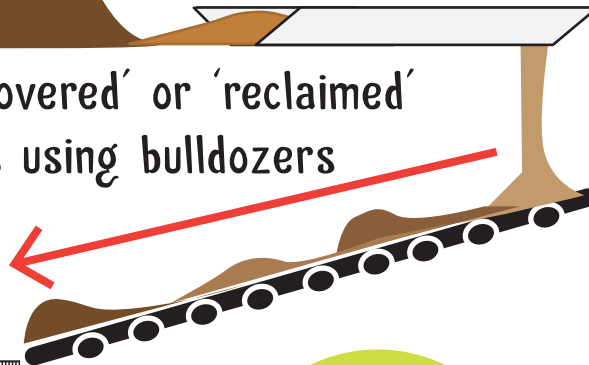


6 The wood chips are then stored in piles

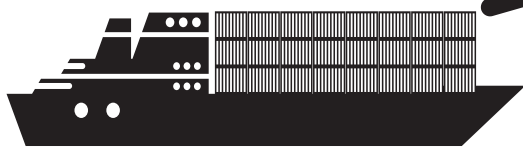
7 Wood chips are 'recovered' or 'reclaimed' from storage piles using bulldozers



8 They are placed on chutes that feed the loading conveyers



9 They are shipped around the globe to countries including: China, India, Japan and Taiwan
